

ENROLMENT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS SEEKING ENROLMENT

Enrolment information is also available for this school in hard copy from our school office.

- 1. Catholic State Integrated schools select preference students on the following grounds.
 - a. The agents for determining preference can be contacted at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit Parish, Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, St Mary's Parish and St Brigid's Parish.
 - b. The criteria to be used by Proprietors, and their authorised agents, when determining whether or not the parents of a child have established such a particular or general religious connection with the Catholic Special Character are:
 - 5.1 The child has been baptised or is being prepared for baptism in the Catholic Church.
 - 5.2 The child's parents/guardians have already allowed one or more of its siblings to be baptised in the Catholic faith.
 - 5.3 At least one parent/guardian is a Catholic, and although their child has not yet been baptised, the child's participation in the life of the school could lead to the parents having the child baptised.
 - 5.4 With the agreement of the child's parent/legal guardian, a significant familial adult such as a grandparent, aunt or uncle who is actively involved in the child's upbringing undertakes to support the child's formation in the faith and practices of the Catholic Church.
 - 5.5 One or both of a child's non-Catholic parents/guardians is preparing to become a Catholic.
- 2. Catholic state integrated schools have open places for non-preference students.
 - a. This school has a maximum of 47 places.
 - b. The next places likely to be available will be in 2024.
 - c. All non-preference applications must be submitted by 31 July to be considered for a place in 2024

Non-Preference places criteria:

- i. The applicants accept that they will be required to pay Attendance Dues as set by the Proprietor of the Diocese of Palmerston North and these are not voluntary.
- ii. The applicants accept that they will be coming to a school of Catholic Special Character and that their place in the school is conditional on their participation in the programme.
- d. Non-Preference Criteria that apply to this school:
 - Siblings of current non-preference students
 - ii. Non-preference applicants who are children of employees of St Peter's College
 - iii. Non-preference students from Catholic feeder schools
 - iv. Siblings/children of former non-preference students
 - v. Other non-preference applicants

Note: If there are more non-preference applicants than vacancies in order of criteria iii, iv and v, St Peter's College will proceed with a ballot at each respective criteria in order of priority, until all vacancies have been filled.

Waiting List Procedure

All unsuccessful applicants may choose to have their names placed on a waiting list. The waiting list will be kept within relevant priority categories, ranked in order. Students on the waiting list may be offered places at a later date if a place becomes available. The waiting list will remain current until the beginning of the next enrolment intake.
